

## **Aurora Lions Club Admission Scholarship**

*Terms:* Awarded to a grade 12 graduating student enrolled in a public secondary school in Aurora who is a resident of Aurora and has demonstrated over the course of their high school years a combination of superior academic achievement and school and community involvement. One scholarship will be awarded each year. Applicants must be residents of Aurora.

*Value:* \$1,000 (non-renewable)

*Eligibility:* Recipients must be admitted to, and subsequently enrol in, a university or community college in Canada. Proof of tuition payment and enrolment is required prior to the transfer of scholarship funds to the student. Funds may be used for tuition, books, residence or any other expenses related to their education.

*Deferral:* Recipients who choose to defer their enrolment for one year may receive their scholarship the following year upon proof of enrolment. Deferral eligibility, however, is limited to one year, after which they will forfeit their eligibility for the scholarship if they do not register.

*Process:* Students from Public and Catholic secondary schools in Aurora may apply at <https://www.auroralions.ca/> A reference from a school official (e.g., teacher, guidance counsellor, principal) familiar with the student is required on the application form. A copy of the student's most recent Grade 12 transcript must accompany their application.

*Application Deadline:* March 31, 2026. Late applications will not be accepted.

All 2026 nominees will be considered by the Board of the Aurora Lions Club no later than June 1, 2026. One scholarship will be offered each year. The Aurora Lions Club reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any given year at its sole discretion.

*The decision of the Board of the Aurora Lions Club is final and may not be appealed.*
